The children have settled back into school life incredibly well and are working hard within their class. Thank you for your continued support.

As well as the children working hard in school, it is important that they continue their learning whenever possible at home; **we will commence with homework from the week beginning 13/09/2021.** To make this as easy as possible for you, and the children, homework will be completed or evidenced online using Education City, TT Rockstars, GoRead and for Early Years and Foundation Stage, EvidenceMe.



For children in Years 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, their teacher will set homework every Monday using EducationCity based on something they have learnt during the week. These activities will be based on Literacy, Maths or Science. Your child will be expected to complete these activities by the following Monday giving them a week for it to be completed.

For children in Nursery and Reception, their teacher will set tasks at the start of every half term for them to complete at home. These task will be sent out using MarvellousMe. Parents/carers can take photos of the children completing the activities and upload them to the EvidenceMe app which can be downloaded from your device's app store.



Further information and login details will be provided for EvidenceMe as soon as possible.



#### Reading

We want children to enjoy reading as much as possible so we encourage them to read books based on topics or themes they enjoy. Your child may bring a book home from school which we expect them to read at home, preferably with someone, whenever an opportunity arises. GoRead can then be used just like a reading diary to keep track of what they have read.

#### Maths/Times Tables

A child's knowledge of times tables is very important. Quick recall of times table facts are used in many different units within the maths curriculum. Every child, between Year 1 and Year 6, will have login details for TTRockstars and we expect them to spend some time practising their times tables every week as part of their homework.
