<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We will continue to strengthen parental engagement in learning, through increasing the support on offer for parents (skills sessions, training in the curriculum and targeted parents' meetings).</li> <li>• Our training for staff this year will include a focus on reading specifically inference skills, problem solving and reasoning, developing greater resilience in our children and the skills to achieve greater depth / high scale scores.</li> <li>• We will continue with our whole school approach to supporting children in developing their skills as readers and writers by focusing on developing children's speaking skills through the creative use of ICT. We want all children to be able to talk confidently about their learning</li> <li>• Accelerate the rate of progress in reading, writing and mathematics for children eligible for Pupil Premium so that they all make at least expected progress with the vast majority making more than expected progress.</li> <li>• Where our Pupil Premium children have additional needs ie new arrival EAL or SEN their individual needs are catered for ensuring that these children make accelerated progress in order to narrow the gap between their attainment and the attainment of non-Pupil Premium children.</li> <li>• Nurture and provide 1-1 support for all pupil premium children so that they develop as happy, confident and resilient learners.</li> </ul>

## Nature of support 2017/18

Support for children eligible for grant:

- Additional support from teaching assistants in the classroom to support learning across the curriculum
- Small group support from Level 3 teaching assistants to accelerate progress in reading, writing and maths
- Tuition from Level 3 teaching assistants to accelerate progress in reading, writing and maths
- 1-1 tuition and small group teaching from experienced teachers to accelerate progress in reading, writing and mathematics
- Small group support from teacher to accelerate language acquisition.

Funding of

- Resources to deliver range of intervention programmes to accelerate progress in reading, writing and maths for PPG pupils
- Software packages and licences
- Training to develop staff's confidence and competence in supporting our new arrival EAL learners in the classroom

Part funding of

- 2 additional Teachers to support reading and writing
- 3 Level Teaching assistants
- Training for teaching assistants supporting children
