### **COVID guidance**

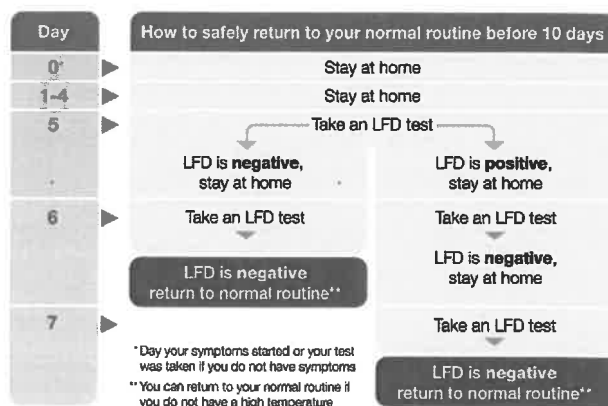
As you will be aware, the COVID guidance has recently been updated. Here are some key points for you at this time...
